Christmas Plays and Performances



However, we will be continuing with the Christmas traditions above and staff will video the performances for parents/carers. During the last week of term, each class will post a video of their Christmas performance on to their Class Dojo for parents/carers to watch at home.

Christmas Party Day

Christmas Cards

Many parents have asked us if the children can send Christmas Cards to each other this year. We know many of the children like to do this at Christmas.

We have thought of a way that children can safely send Christmas Cards, while keeping cross contamination of the Coronavirus at a minimum.

In the mornings, staff will have a special post box for children to post their Christmas Cards in. We will keep this box in isolation/quarantine until Party Day when we will hand out the cards addressed to each child to take home.

As such, the last post for school Christmas Cards will have to be <u>Friday 11th December 2020</u>. All children will need to post their Christmas Cards in to their class boxes before the end of the day on Friday 11th December 2020. This way, all the cards children take home will have been quarantined for the advised 72 hours before being passed on to their friends.
