There are 3 shells on the beach. A big wave comes in leaving 3 more shells. How many shells are now on the beach?

A girl puts 8 shells into her bucket. She then finds 2 more and puts them in her bucket. How many shells are now in the bucket?

A boy and a girl are collecting shells. They both collect 4 shells each. How many do they have altogether?

A boy has 5 shells in his hand. He drops 3, how many are left in his hand?

A girl takes 7 shells home from her trip to the beach. When she gets home, she finds 1 is broken and she has to put it in the bin. How many shells does she have left?
